It simplifies backup, disaster recovery, and system migration, allowing you to protect the full spectrum of computing environments including physical machines, virtual machines, workstations, individual servers or groups of servers in either physical or virtual environments. - Computer with Pentium III class processor; minimal requirement for computers with Windows Vista (32 bit) is an 800 MHz processor; for computers with Windows XP (32 bit), the requirement is a 650 MHz processor. A faster processor will give better performance. - 1 GB of RAM (2 GB recommended; 4 GB minimum). The more memory, the faster the computer will run. However, the installer requires about 700 MB for pre-processor and boot sequence (about 2.5 MB to support Windows XP service pack 3) and wants about 1.4 GB for the operating system itself. - 2 GB of available disk space; Acronis True Image 2010 V13 Build 6053 Bootable Rescue Media Bui 64 Bit uses only 375 MB to provide an installation environment, leaving adequate space to store your data afterwards.
